
Setting Dike

ACCESSIBILITY INFORMATION

- This route has no stiles but does include other structures i.e. steps, gates, boardwalks or bridges.
- This route includes one or more busy road crossings or a section of road walking.
- This route includes sections of difficult terrain i.e. rough ground, boggy grass or scree.
- This route lies within remote areas, away from settlements. You are advised to carry a mobile phone and advise someone of your planned route before setting off.
- Please don't drop litter, use a litter bin or take it home with you.
- Please pick up after your dog. Use a litter bin to dispose of the waste or take it home with you.

DESCRIPTION

- I Starting your walk at the junction of National Avenue and Setting Dike footpath, between Briarfield Road and Wises Farm Road, take the grassed footpath on the right / north side of Setting Dike Drain and follow the footpath west.
- 2 On reaching County Road North, cross the busy road, and continue along the public footpath.
- 3 Cross the service road between Cropton Road and Bricknell Playing Fields & continue on the footpath.
- 4 Near the railway line you will need to turn right and follow the public footpath through the woodland.
- 5 As you pass a footbridge on your left, proceed straight ahead along the segregated footway and cycle track that connects to Boldron Mews.
- 6 Turn right at the junction with Dent Road and carry-on walking to
- 7 Bishop Alcock Road junction and turn right follow the footway passing a school sports ground on the right.
- 8 Turn right at the next T junction and walk to Hotham Road North
- 9 Cross Hotham Road North and turn left.
- 10 On reaching Bricknell Avenue turn right.
- 11 At the Bricknell Avenue / National Avenue junction, cross National Avenue then turn right and follow the footway.
- 12 On reaching the National Avenue / County Road North junction cross the road.
- 13 Continue walking National Avenue, where you will arrive at the starting point.

FEATURES OF INTEREST

• Bishop Alcock Road was the 20th century home of Hull Grammar School (founded in 1330 by John Alcock (Bishop) until 1988.
